This half term our topic in KS2 is 'Where does water come from?'. As part of this topic, we have been looking at the water cycle, understanding where water comes from and its importance for us. We have carried out some exciting experiments with water to understand the cycle fully.



In English we have enjoyed reading and exploring 'The snail and the whale' story, with students using lots of props to retell the story themselves. Some students will be writing their own story with new characters that they have created.

We started the topic with a fun water party on the field and we are ending it with a visit to 'The National Marine Aquarium' to see all of the marine life featured in the book. (Apart from the Whale!).

Next half term our topic is 'How do people Travel'.
