## Topics This Term

This half term, our topic in KS2 is 'What makes a home?'. As part of this topic, we will be looking at where our home is, who is in our home and what our homes are made of. We will also be looking at homes in other countries. Each class will be focusing on a different country and the types of houses they have, looking closely at the materials that are used to build the houses and thinking about why these materials are used. This topic offers our learners plenty of building and junk modelling opportunities that help develop and enhance skills such as creativity, problem solving, planning, and evaluation skills.

Some of our pupils will be exploring buildings in a multi-sensory approach, looking at the variety of materials used to build them. Our art work will be displayed in the Hall after half term.

Our PSHE focus is internet safety and keeping safe online. In Maths, our focus is Measure.

Next half term, our topic will be 'How do I call the emergency services?'. Our aim will be to learn what is an emergency?; what are the emergency services?; how do we call the emergency services?; and when should we call the emergency services?.
