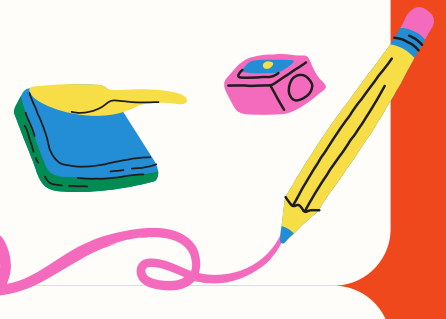

Topics

Our topic in the first half term is 'Who lives in the rainforest?'

We will be reading the book 'Eco Girl' by Ken Wilson-Max.

This topic will give us opportunities to discover where the rainforests of the world are, what the weather is like in the rainforests and what animals live in the rainforest.



We will also be exploring chocolate, looking at where it comes from, how many different types there are and what we can do with it. We will look at packaging and design our own to go with our own chocolate bars that we will be designing and making later this term.

In maths we continue to build our understanding of numbers focusing on what they are made of.

In PE we will be playing invasion games and learning skills to help us move around the hall, exploring different ways of moving and practicing stopping and starting.

In PSHE we are learning about respectful relationships and people who care for us.
